## THREE ARTS GROUPS WELCOME THE NASHER SCULPTURE CENTER TO THE DALLAS ARTS DISTRICT

### *“A Bouquet of Song” Set for Thursday, October 23 at the Crow Collection*

DALLAS – October 1, 2003 – The Arts District Chorale, a premier 25-voice ensemble that promotes choral excellence through artistic performance in the unique venues within the downtown Dallas Arts District, will perform a concert in celebration of the opening of the Nasher Sculpture Center.

The concert, entitled, “A Bouquet of Song,” will be performed on Thursday, October 23, 2003, 7:00 p.m. at the Trammell and Margaret Crow Collection of Asian Art, 2010 Flora Street, in the downtown Arts District. The Arts District Chorale is under the direction of artistic director H. Michie Akin.

The program includes the *Trois chansons de Charles d’Orléans* by Claude Debussy, as well as Anglo-American and American songs, in unique arrangements by Aaron Copland, Alf Houkam, and Stephen Paulhus — some with harp accompaniment.

The concert is collaboration between the Crow Collection of Asian Art, the Arts District Chorale, and the Arts District Friends. The concert will be preceded by a wine reception at 6:00 p.m.

Admission to the concert is free. However seating is limited to the first 125 guests. Both the Crow Collection and the Nasher Sculpture Center are open until 9:00 p.m. on this very special evening, which will allow guests to enjoy the concert at the Crow Collection, then walk across the street to experience the Nasher Center during its opening week.
