Valentine's Eve Serenade Promises a Night of Chocolate, Wine & Song in the Downtown Arts District

Three Arts District Groups Combine for "Tangos Among Friends" Concert

DALLAS (Jan. 20, 2004) — A Valentine's Eve Serenade featuring quintessential love songs by Cole Porter and sensual tangos by Astor Piazzolla is set for 7:30 p.m. on Friday, February 13, 2004, at the Crow Collection of Asian Art in the Dallas Arts District.

The event, entitled "Tangos Among Friends," is a collaboration of the Trammell and Margaret Crow Collection of Asian Art, the Arts District Friends, and the Arts District Chorale.

The Arts District Chorale is a premier 30-voice ensemble that promotes choral excellence through artistic performance, primarily in the unique venues of the downtown Arts District. The Chorale is under the direction of conductor and founding artistic director, H. Michie Akin.

"Tangos Among Friends" is a reprise of last year's "Sing Me a Love Song" program that was performed to a standing-room-only audience. "Tangos" promises to be just as fun and lively, as the audience will again be treated to a suite of sweetness — chocolate, wine and song — in the Crow Collection's Gallery III.

The 7:30 p.m. concert will be preceded by a wine and hors d'oeuvre reception at 6:30 p.m. Champagne and dessert will be served during the choral performance. Both the reception and concert will be held at the Crow Collection of Asian Art at 2010 Flora Street in Dallas. Reduced rate parking (\$3.00) is available in the Trammell Crow Center underground parking garage. Patrons should bring their parking ticket to the reception for validation.

Tickets are \$30 per adult or \$50 per couple. Reservations are required and may be made with a major credit card by calling the Crow Collection at (214) 979-6437.

Seating is limited to 125, so guests are encouraged to make reservations as soon as possible for this very special Valentine's Eve performance.
